Key findings from the mid-term evaluation

RRF succeeded in its initial ambition: to support EU's economic and social recovery from COVID-19

The first major performance-based instrument where payments are conditional upon fulfilment

Delivering on both **investments and reforms** and contributing to the **implementation of CSRs**

RRF is already having **real results** in Member States

Strong **alignment** of MS policies with EU priorities (green & digital transition)

High degree of ownership by Member States

The RRF was **agile** in reacting to new challenges (e.g. war, inflation)
